Christmas Worship Plans

Because of the rising positivity rate of Covid-19 in Westmoreland County (15.23%) and the increase of exposure instances along with the decision by the Greater Latrobe School District to begin full remote learning now through January 18, 2021, we have decided to cancel in-person worship services for Christmas Eve. This was not an easy decision and it will not be met with complete agreement. We do this because we are called by God through our baptism to care for others in the body of Christ. The safety and health of all our members has been at the forefront of all our decisions regarding in-person worship and meetings. We will be broadcasting Christmas Eve services on Facebook, YouTube and WCNS Radio. We are investigating other outlets that may be beneficial as well. We will offer drivethru communion twice on Christmas Eve from 11:30am - 12:30pm and 7:30pm - 8:30pm. For drive-thru communion enter the carport drive from the alley and exit onto Weldon Street. Christmas Day worship will be broadcast at 10:00am on WCNS radio.

Council Elections & 2021 Budget Vote

You received a mailing in your regular mail this week with the proposed budget for 2021 and the slate of Congregation Council nominees. Voting will take place today, Sunday,

December 6 from 11:00am to 1:00pm.

It will be a drive-in procedure. Balloting will take place on Weldon Street only. If you are coming to Drive-thru Communion and wish to vote, when exiting onto Weldon Street, stop at the balloting location to receive a ballot. When you ask for a ballot, you will state your name and the person distributing the ballot will mark your attendance on an approved list of voting members. After you have completed your ballot, you will drop it in a box and it will be counted by tellers following the balloting. Please wear a mask when interacting with the person(s) distributing the ballots. Please bring your own pen or pencil to complete your ballot. We understand this is very different than any other meeting we have had in the past. We are working to accommodate as many people as possible with pandemic limitations. Please take the time to vote.

Drive-Thru Communion

Drive-thru communion will be offered today and also December 13 and 20 from 11:00amnoon. Please enter the carport drive from the alley and exit onto Weldon Street. If you have offering or items for church, a box is available. Even though we cannot be together in the same way, we share a relationship in the body of Christ and are strengthened through our participation in this Holy Sacrament.
