Come get some fresh air and enjoy a socially-distanced outside activity!

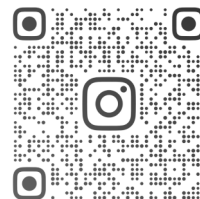

Have you been experiencing issues when listening to the church's radio broadcast?

*Check what channel you are tuned into and be sure you are connected to **1480WCNS AM** or **98.7Jack FM** (this is the parent station of 97.3Lite FM). There has been some local frequency interference. To strengthen your radio signal, try moving your radio to a different location/room and fine tuning what station you are on to the above listed. We continue to try to improve the radio broadcast as much as we can outside of the frequency issues being experienced.*
