# EXPLORE THE GREAT OUTDOORS! SATURDAY, MARCH 27<sup>TH</sup>, 2021 AT 10:00AM

# <u>From the intersection of Route 981 and Route 22 at New Alexandria:</u>

Go north on Rt. 981 for 4.6 miles. Turn right onto Tunnelton Road, continue for 1.9 miles. At stop sign, turn left, cross Conemaugh River, continue on Tunnelton Road for 0.9 miles. Turn right on Auen Road, continue for 0.7 miles. Turn right into the Conemaugh Dam parking area, proceed into the large parking lot between restrooms and playground. About 25 minutes from Latrobe.
