### **CHURCH OPENING NEWS**

The Council unanimously approved the recommendation of the Return to Worship Committee for Sunday School for both adults and children to resume in person on April 11. The week of April 18 committees and Council may resume in person meetings in the church building and the first week in May all other groups may resume meeting in person. All appropriate mitigation procedures will remain in place (masks required, social distancing, no food, no singing).
