C12.02.- Council members be allowed to serve 2 full consecutive 3-year terms of office plus the balance of any remaining term to which they were appointed rather than a single 3-year term plus the balance of any remaining term to which they were appointed.

C12.05.C- Council shall have the constitutional authorization to spend up to \$40,000 on a non-budgeted item, rather than the current \$20,000.

B12.15.02.-The SWPA Synod Committee on Constitutions and Bylaws recommended revisions to our bylaws.
