As we prepare to give our tithes and offerings this morning, think on this from Luke 21: "He saw the rich putting their gifts into the temple treasure. He also saw a poor widow put in two very small copper coins." Upon seeing this happen, Jesus said, "Truly I tell you, this poor widow has put in more than all the others. All these people gave their gifts out of their wealth; but she out of her poverty put in all she had to live on."

Now, we'd never ask anyone to give all they had to live on. However, the principle here is that the amount of the offering isn't the main issue. The motives of the heart and the sacrifice required by the giver are more meaningful than the dollar amount of the gift. Whatever the amount of your gift today, remember that God cares much more about the state of your heart as you give than the amount of the gift itself.
