On the other hand, if their hope was in wealth, they probably had a very hard time moving past the initial shock. These verses remind us that what we have comes from God and that our hope should be in Him ... not in our finances. Part of our responsibility is to steward our resources wisely—that includes giving as generously as you can to help others.

When you're a cheerful and generous giver, you're honoring God with your finances. This act of worship helps you keep money in proper perspective and it helps others. That's a combination that can have an incredible impact.
