



We conclude our short series talking about Trinity's budget. Today our focus is on **"other" income**. Other budgeted income comes from a variety of sources:

- Rent receipts, primarily from the Head Start program that has rented space at Trinity for many years.
- Seasonal envelopes, such as Easter, Advent, Christmas, Energy, etc.
- Radio Broadcasts, and receipts from various committee activities.

These sources total approximately seven percent of the total budget.

Donations are also made to numerous established funds that are kept separate from the church budget, such as:

- Renovation Fund – money to cover the church's mortgage payments and other Property needs
- Music at Trinity Fund, Memorial Fund, Fine Arts Fund, Assistance and Discretionary Fund, etc. These funds can be used as their names indicate.
- Memorials

Contributions can be made to these funds by specifying the fund name when the contribution is made. These funds can carry balances from year to year if the money is not spent.
